- Was there anything here that surprised you?
- What might be another way to interpret that student's behaviour?
- What does that student response tell you about her or his understanding of the topic?
- How might you plan for what would happen next for these students, given the evidence here?
- Can you give me an example of what this might look like in your classroom?
- Could you explain that in a different way?
- What do you think would happen if....(suggest an alternate scenario)?
